- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.04(c)(2), Penal Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (2) "Elderly individual" means a person $\underline{60}$ [$\underline{65}$] years
- 8 of age or older.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 22.04(d), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 (d) The actor, including an employee of a nursing facility
- 12 licensed under Chapter 242, Health and Safety Code, an assisted
- 13 living facility licensed under Chapter 247, Health and Safety Code,
- 14 and an intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded
- 15 licensed under Chapter 252, Health and Safety Code, has assumed
- 16 care, custody, or control if the actor [he] has by act, words, or
- 17 course of conduct acted so as to cause a reasonable person to
- 18 conclude that the actor [he] has accepted responsibility for
- 19 protection, food, shelter, and medical care for a child, elderly
- 20 individual, or disabled individual.
- 21 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to an offense committed on or after September 1, 2005. An offense
- committed before September 1, 2005, is covered by the law in effect
- 24 when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in

- 1 effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense
- 2 was committed before September 1, 2005, if any element of the
- 3 offense occurred before that date.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
