## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 301, Property Code, is
- amended by adding Section 301.028 to read as follows:

  Sec. 301.028. CRIMINAL CONVICTION. (a) In this section,
- 8 "nonviolent criminal activity" means criminal activity that does
  9 not have as any of its elements the use, attempted use, or
  10 threatened use of physical force substantial enough to cause, or be
- 11 reasonably likely to cause, serious bodily injury or property
- 12 damage.

- (b) A person may not refuse to rent, after the making of a
- bona fide offer, refuse to negotiate for the rental of, or in any
- other manner make unavailable or deny a dwelling to another because
- of a conviction for nonviolent criminal activity.
- 17 <u>(c) A person may not discriminate against another in the</u>
- 18 terms, conditions, or privileges of a rental of a dwelling or in
- 19 providing services or facilities in connection with a rental of a
- 20 <u>dwelling because of a conviction for nonviolent criminal activity.</u>
- 21 (d) Notwithstanding Subsection (b) or (c), this section
- 22 does not prohibit discrimination against a person because the
- 23 person:
- 24 (1) has been convicted under federal law or the law of

- 1 any state of the illegal manufacture or distribution of a
- 2 controlled substance; or
- 3 (2) is required to register as a sex offender under
- 4 Chapter 62, Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a complaint filed with
- 6 the Texas Workforce Commission civil rights division on or after
- 7 the effective date of this Act. A complaint filed before that date
- 8 is governed by the law in effect on the date the complaint was
- 9 filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
