(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter, a person may not be required to complete the range 1-18 instruction portion of a handgun proficiency course to obtain or 1-19 1-20 1-21 renew a concealed handgun license issued under this subchapter the person: 1-22 (1) is currently serving in or is honorably discharged from: 1-23 (A) the army, navy, air force, coast guard, or marine corps of the United States or an auxiliary service or reserve unit of one of those branches of the armed forces; or 1-24 1-25 1-26 1-27 (B) the state military forces, defined by 1-28 Section 431.001; and (2) has, within the five years preceding the date of the person's application for an original or renewed license, as applicable, completed a course of training in handgun proficiency 1-29 1-30 1-31 or familiarization as part of the person's service with the armed 1-32 forces or state military forces.

(b) The director by rule shall adopt a procedure by which a license holder who is exempt under Subsection (a) from the range instruction portion of the handgun proficiency requirement may 1-33 1-34 1-35 1-36 submit a form demonstrating the license holder's qualification for 1-37 an exemption under that subsection. The form must provide 1-38 1-39 sufficient information to allow the department to verify whether the license holder qualifies for the exemption.
