6	SECTION 1. Section 33.124, Natural Resources Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	Sec. 33.124. PERMITS PROHIBITED FOR CERTAIN STRUCTURES.
9	The board may not grant a permit which authorizes the continued use
10	of a structure located within 1,000 feet of[+
11	[(1)] privately owned littoral <u>residential</u> property,
12	without written consent of the littoral owner[+
13	[(2) any federal or state wildlife sanctuary or
14	refuge; or
15	[(3) any federal, state, county, or city park
16	bordering on coastal public land].
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
18	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
19	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
20	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
21	Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
