- 8 Sec. 33.124. PERMITS PROHIBITED FOR CERTAIN STRUCTURES.
- 9 The board may not grant a permit which authorizes the continued use
- of a structure located within 1,000 feet of [+
- 11 $\left[\frac{1}{2}\right]$ privately owned littoral residential property,
- 12 without written consent of the littoral owner[+
- 13 [(2) any federal or state wildlife sanctuary or
- 14 refuge; or
- 15 [(3) any federal, state, county, or city park
- 16 bordering on coastal public land].
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
