1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the issuance of permits by the School Land Board  
1-11 authorizing continued use of certain structures on coastal public  
1-12 land.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Section 33.124, Natural Resources Code, is  
1-15 amended to read as follows:

1-16 Sec. 33.124. PERMITS PROHIBITED FOR CERTAIN STRUCTURES.  
1-17 The board may not grant a permit which authorizes the continued use  
1-18 of a structure located within 1,000 feet of [+

1-19 [~~(1)~~] privately owned littoral residential property,  
1-20 without written consent of the littoral owner [+

1-21 [~~(2)~~ any federal or state wildlife sanctuary or  
1-22 refuge, or

1-23 [~~(3)~~ any federal, state, county, or city park  
1-24 bordering on coastal public land].

1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
