1 [(D)] \$5,000 plus or minus an amount to be 2 determined annually beginning on October 1, 1997, to reflect 3 changes in the new car component of the Consumer Price Index for All 4 Urban Consumers published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics.

5 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act 6 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 7 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 8 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 9 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 10 waiver or authorization is granted.

SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to a person who receives financial assistance under Chapter 31, Human Resources Code, on or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of the date on which eligibility for the financial assistance was determined.
