7	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, is
8	amended by adding Section 1579.109 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 1579.109. CERTAIN MENTAL DISORDERS IN CHILDREN. (a)
10	In this section:
11	(1) "Child" means a person younger than 19 years of
12	age.
13	(2) "Mental disorder" means a disorder that is
14	identified in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental
15	Disorders, fourth edition, or in a subsequent edition of that
16	manual that the commissioner by rule adopts to take the place of the
17	fourth edition or any subsequent edition for the purposes of this
18	subdivision and that results in a significant impairment of a

- required by Section 1579.109, Insurance Code, as added by this Act,
- 23 is being used by enrollees in health coverage plans to which that
- 24 section applies; and
- 25 (2) the impact of the required coverage on the cost of

- 3 (c) The Teacher Retirement System of Texas, the Texas

- 7 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to group health coverage
- 8 under Chapter 1579, Insurance Code, as amended by this Act, on or
- 9 after September 1, 2005.
- 10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
