- 2 relating to the punishment for fraudulent use or possession of an
- 3 elderly person's identifying information.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 32.51(c), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (c) An offense under this section is a state jail felony,
- 8 except that the offense is a felony of the third degree if it is
- 9 shown on the trial of the offense that in committing the offense the
- 10 defendant obtained, possessed, transferred, or used the
- 11 identifying information of an elderly individual, as that term is
- defined by Section 22.04.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 16 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 17 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 18 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 19 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 20 committed before that date.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
