4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 194.002(d), Health and Safety Code, is

amended to read as follows:

- 7 (d) Not later than the ninth day of each month, each
- 8 district clerk shall file with the bureau of vital statistics a
- 9 completed report for each divorce or annulment of marriage granted
- 10 in the district court during the preceding calendar month. Before
- 11 the clerk files a report with the bureau under this subsection, the
- 12 clerk must verify that the report contains all of the information
- 13 required by Subsection (a). If a report does not include the
- information required by Subsection (a)(3) or (4), the clerk must
- 15 complete that information on the report before the clerk files the
- 16 report with the bureau.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
