BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-9 1-10 1-11 SECTION 1. Section 31.002, Civil Practice and Remedies 1-12 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows: (h) A court may enter or enforce an order under this section 1-13 that requires the turnover of nonexempt property without identifying in the order the specific property subject to turnover.

SECTION 2. This Act applies to the collection of any 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 judgment, without regard to whether the judgment is rendered 1-17 before, on, or after the effective date of this Act. 1-18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-19 1-20 1-21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
