- 13 by Section 74.001, Civil Practice and Remedies Code [1.03, Medical
- 14 Liability and Insurance Improvement Act of Texas (Article 4590i,
- 15 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes)];
- 16 (2) the hospital has knowledge that the person has a
- 17 reportable disease and has medical reason to believe that the
- 18 person had the disease when the person was admitted to the hospital;
- 19 and
- 20 (3) the emergency medical service personnel, peace
- 21 officer, or fire fighter was exposed to the reportable disease
- 22 during the course of duty.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an act occurring on or
- 24 after the effective date of this Act.
