- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 622, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER I. VEHICLES TRANSPORTING <u>AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS</u> [COTTON]
- 8 OR [COTTON PROCESSINC] EQUIPMENT
- 9 Sec. 622.101. VEHICLE TRANSPORTING AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT
- 10 [COTTON] OR PROCESSING EQUIPMENT. A single motor vehicle used
- 11 exclusively to transport agricultural product [seed cotton]
- 12 modules, <u>agricultural products</u> [cotton, cotton burrs], or
- 13 equipment used to transport or process <u>agricultural products</u>
- 14 [cotton], including a burr spreader, may not be operated on a
- 15 highway or road if the vehicle is:
- 16 (1) wider than 10 feet and the highway has not been
- designated by the commission under Section 621.202 [if the vehicle
- 18 is registered under Section 502.277];
- 19 (2) longer than 48 feet; or
- 20 (3) higher than 14 feet 6 inches.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 622.953(a), Transportation Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- 23 (a) The weight limitations of Section 621.101 do not apply
- 24 to a single motor vehicle used exclusively to transport

- agricultural products or equipment used to transport or process
- 2 agricultural products [seed cotton modules].
- 3 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 4 an offense committed on or after September 1, 2005. An offense
- 5 committed before September 1, 2005, is covered by the law as it
- 6 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 7 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
