1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to fees for registration and inspection of certain fuel
1-11 measuring and dispensing devices.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 13.001(a), Agriculture Code, is amended
1-14 by adding Subdivision (3) to read as follows:

1-15 (3) "Pump" means a gasoline, kerosene, or diesel fuel
1-16 measuring or dispensing device.

1-17 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 13.1151, Agriculture
1-18 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-19 Sec. 13.1151. FEES FOR REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION.

1-20 SECTION 3. Section 13.1151(a), Agriculture Code, is amended
1-21 to read as follows:

1-22 [~~(a)~~] The department may charge the owner or operator of a
1-23 device a fee, as provided by department rule, to recover the costs
1-24 of [~~for the~~] registration and inspection of a pump, scale, [~~or~~] bulk
1-25 or liquefied petroleum gas metering device, or other measuring or
1-26 dispensing device required to be registered or inspected under
1-27 [~~Section 13.1011 of~~] this chapter [~~code. The department shall~~
1-28 ~~determine the amount of the fee based on the number and the capacity~~
1-29 ~~of the scales, pumps, or metering devices being operated].~~

1-30 SECTION 4. Sections 13.1011(e) and 13.1151(b)-(f),
1-31 Agriculture Code, are repealed.

1-32 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
