- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 572, Government Code, is

- 8 Sec. 572.060. SOLICITATION OF OR RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING
- 9 CONTRIBUTIONS TO CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS AND GOVERNMENTAL
- 10 ENTITIES. (a) A state officer or state employee may:
- 11 (1) solicit from any person a contribution to:
- 12 (A) an organization that is exempt from income
- 13 taxation under Section 501(a), Internal Revenue Code, by being
- 14 <u>listed under Section 501(c)(3)</u>, Internal Revenue Code; or
- 15 (B) a governmental entity; or
- 16 (2) recommend to any person that the person make a
- 17 contribution to an organization or entity described by Subdivision
- 18 (1).

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- (b) A monetary contribution solicited or recommended as
- 20 provided by Subsection (a) must:
- 21 <u>(1) be paid or made directly to the charitable</u>
- 22 organization or governmental entity by the person making the
- 23 contribution;
- 24 (2) be in the form of a check, money order, or similar

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- 1 instrument payable to the charitable organization or governmental
- 2 entity; or
- 3 (3) be in the form of a deduction from a state
- 4 employee's salary or wage payment under the state employee
- 5 charitable campaign under Subchapter I, Chapter 659.
- 6 (c) A contribution solicited or recommended as provided by
- 7 Subsection (a) that is not a monetary contribution must be
- 8 <u>delivered directly to the charitable organization or governmental</u>
- 9 entity by the person making the contribution.
- 10 (d) A contribution paid as provided by Subsection (b) or
- 11 delivered as provided by Subsection (c) is not:
- 12 <u>(1) a political contribution to, or political</u>
- 13 expenditure on behalf of, the state officer or state employee for
- 14 purposes of Title 15, Election Code;
- 15 (2) an expenditure for purposes of Chapter 305; or
- 16 (3) a benefit to the state officer or state employee
- for purposes of Sections 36.08 and 36.09, Penal Code.
