 county officers is held, the commissioners court may authorize the

 county clerk to send by mail an application to vote by mail to each

 person in the county eligible to vote by mail under Section 82.003
- other than a person whose name appears on the suspense list.
- 13 (b) A voter who completes an application sent under
 14 Subsection (a) and requests a ballot for a party primary election is
 15 also considered to have requested a ballot for any resulting runoff
 16 election and the general election for state and county officers
- 17 held in the same year.

- 18 <u>(c) A voter who completes an application sent under</u>
