2 (9) the incorporated area and extraterritorial
3 jurisdiction of the City of Sugar Land located in Fort Bend County.
4 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
5 beginning with the 2005 fall semester.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
