## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to authorizing a temporary wind up permit for a
- 3 concentrated animal feeding operation the permit for which has been
- 4 revoked.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 26, Water Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Section 26.0287 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 26.0287. TEMPORARY WIND UP PERMIT FOR CONCENTRATED
- 9 ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATION. (a) The commission shall issue a
- 10 temporary wind up permit to a person whose permit to operate a
- 11 concentrated animal feeding operation is revoked. The term of the
- 12 temporary wind up permit is six months.
- 13 (b) If the revocation of the permit is appealed, the agency
- or court hearing the appeal by order shall extend the temporary wind
- up permit for the duration of the appeal process and by order shall
- 16 extend the wind up permit for three months from the date of the
- 17 appeals decision if the decision supports the revocation.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by Section 26.0287, Water
- 19 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a permit revocation
- 20 proceeding that is initiated on or after September 1, 2005.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
