- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Sections 364.012(b) and (f), Health and Safety 5 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- To prohibit the disposal of municipal or industrial 7 solid waste in a county, the commissioners court must adopt an 8 ordinance in the general form prescribed for municipal ordinances 9 [specifically designating the area of the county in which municipal 10 or industrial solid waste disposal is not prohibited].
 - The commission may not grant an application for a permit to process or dispose of municipal or industrial solid waste in an area in which the processing or disposal of municipal or industrial solid waste is prohibited by an ordinance, unless the county violated Subsection (e) in passing the ordinance or except as provided by this subsection. The commission by rule may specify the procedures for determining whether an application is for the processing or disposal of municipal or industrial solid waste in an area for which that processing or disposal is prohibited by an ordinance. The commission may grant an application for a permit to dispose of municipal or industrial solid waste in an area in which the disposal of municipal or industrial solid waste is prohibited by a county ordinance adopted under this section if:

1 (1) the commission determines that the area the permit 2 application proposes for that activity is appropriate for that 3 activity; and 4 (2) the ordinance: (A) does not designate an area of the county in 5 6 which municipal or industrial solid waste disposal is not 7 prohibited; or 8 (B) designates one or more areas of the county in which municipal or industrial solid waste is not prohibited and the 9 commission determines that none of those areas is appropriate for 10 11 that activity. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 12
