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5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is

amended by adding Section 55.1754 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 55.1754. TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY--SAN MARCOS;

9 ADDITIONAL BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted

by this subchapter, including the authority granted by Section

55.1744, the board of regents of the Texas State University System

may issue bonds in accordance with this subchapter in the aggregate

principal amount not to exceed \$40 million to finance the

acquisition, purchase, construction, improvement, renovation,

facilities, or related infrastructure for the Round Rock Higher

(b) The board may pledge irrevocably to the payment of those

(e) Approval of the board is not required to acquire real 1 2 property that is financed by bonds issued under Section 55.17(e)(3) or (4), 55.1713-55.1718, 55.1721-55.1728, 55.1735(a)(1), 55.174, 3 4 55.1742, 55.1743, [ex] 55.1744, or 55.1754, except that the board 5 shall review all real property to be financed by bonds issued under 6 those sections to determine whether the property meets the standards adopted by the board for cost, efficiency, and space use. 7 8 If the property does not meet those standards, the board shall 9 notify the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the 10 house of representatives, and the Legislative Budget Board.

SECTION 4. Section 61.058(b), Education Code, is amended to

- This section does not apply to construction, repair, or 13 14 rehabilitation financed by bonds issued under Section 55.17(e)(3) 15 or (4), 55.1713-55.1718, 55.1721-55.1728, 55.174, 55.1742, 55.1743, [or 55.1744, or 55.1754, except that the board shall 16 17 review all construction, repair, or rehabilitation to be financed by bonds issued under those sections to determine whether the 18 construction, rehabilitation, or repair meets the standards 19 adopted by board rule for cost, efficiency, and space use. If the 20 21 construction, rehabilitation, or repair does not meet those standards, the board shall notify the governor, the lieutenant 22 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the 23 24 Legislative Budget Board.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
