## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

L	AN ACT

- 2 relating to training for Department of Family and Protective
- 3 Services personnel receiving reports of child abuse and neglect.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 261, Family Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 261.3016 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 261.3016. TRAINING OF PERSONNEL RECEIVING REPORTS OF
- 8 ABUSE AND NEGLECT. The department shall develop, in cooperation
- 9 with local law enforcement officials and the Commission on State
- 10 Emergency Communications, a training program for department
- 11 personnel who receive reports of abuse and neglect. The training
- 12 program must include information on:
- 13 (1) the proper methods of screening reports of abuse
- 14 and neglect; and
- 15 (2) ways to determine the seriousness of a report,
- 16 including determining whether a report alleges circumstances that
- 17 could result in the death of or serious harm to a child or whether
- 18 the report is less serious in nature.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
