4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 223, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 223.049 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 223.049. TEMPORARY EXIT SIGNS. If an improvement to a
8	designated controlled access highway requires, while the
9	improvement is being made, that an exit be closed or moved, a new
10	exit be opened, or a sign that provides information about an exit be
11	removed or covered, the contract for the improvement must require
12	the erection of temporary signs providing notice of the location of
13	exits in the improvement area and appropriate information
14	concerning streets, highways, and districts to which the exits
15	provide access.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
17	is amended by adding Section 545.0653 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 545.0653. RESTRICTION ON COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE IN
19	CONSTRUCTION OR MAINTENANCE WORK ZONE. (a) This section applies
20	only on a highway that:
21	(1) is in the designated state highway system;
22	(2) is designated a controlled access facility; and
23	(3) has a minimum of two travel lanes, excluding
24	access or frontage roads, in each direction of traffic.

- 1 (b) An operator of a commercial motor vehicle, as defined by
- 2 <u>Section 545.307, in a construction or maintenance work zone, as</u>
- 3 defined by Section 472.022, may drive only in the lane farthest to
- 4 the right except:
- 5 <u>(1) to pass another vehicle;</u>
 - (2) to enter or exit the highway; or
- 7 (3) as provided by Subsection (c).
- 8 <u>(c) The executive director of the Texas Department of</u>
- 9 Transportation or the executive director's designee may suspend or
- 10 rescind the restriction imposed by Subsection (b) in all or part of
- 11 the construction or maintenance work zone if the executive director
- 12 or designee determines that the restriction creates an unsafe
- 13 condition.

- 14 (d) The Texas Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 15 maintain official traffic control devices necessary to implement
- and enforce this section. A restriction imposed by Subsection (b)
- 17 may not be enforced until the appropriate traffic control devices
- 18 are in place.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 223.049, Transportation Code, as added
- 20 by this Act, applies only to a contract entered into or modified on
- 21 or after the effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
