6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 773, Health and Safety
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 773.015 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 773.015. IDENTIFICATION OF CERTAIN PATIENTS RECEIVING
9	EMERGENCY PREHOSPITAL CARE. Emergency medical services personnel
10	or emergency room medical or admissions personnel may take the
11	thumbprint of a person who receives emergency prehospital care if
12	the person:
13	(1) does not possess personal identification at the
14	time the care is administered;
15	(2) is unconscious;
16	(3) is transported across the Texas-Mexico border by
17	ambulance or helicopter while receiving emergency prehospital
18	care; and
19	(4) is delivered to a hospital that has digital
20	fingerprinting capabilities.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
