5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 659, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 659.0126 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 659.0126. SALARY FOR DISTRICT JUDGE PRESIDING OVER
8	MULTIDISTRICT LITIGATION. (a) Notwithstanding Section 659.012 or
9	any other law, a district judge who presides over at least one
10	proceeding transferred to a district court under Subchapter H,
11	Chapter 74, in a state fiscal year is entitled to the same increase
12	in annual salary from the state for that fiscal year as a local
13	administrative district judge is entitled to under Section
14	<u>659.0125.</u>
15	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, supplemental
16	compensation paid to a district judge under this section is not
17	included as part of the district judge's total annual salary for
18	purposes of computing another salary that is based on the salary of
19	the district judge.

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
