- 23 (9) injures an animal[, other than cattle, horses,

- 1 authority or the owner's effective consent; or
- 2 (10) seriously overworks an animal.
- 3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 6 governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
- 7 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 8 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 9 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was
- 10 committed before that date.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
