- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2.006, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), the clerk may not issue
- 8 a marriage license for which both applicants are absent unless the
- 9 person applying on behalf of each absent applicant provides to the
- 10 clerk an affidavit of the applicant declaring that the applicant
- 11 is:
- 12 (1) on active duty as a member of the armed forces of
- the United States or the state military forces; or
- 14 (2) confined in a correctional facility, as defined by
- 15 <u>Section 1.07, Penal Code.</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
- 17 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to an application for a marriage license submitted on or after the
- 19 effective date of this Act. An application for a marriage license
- 20 submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 21 law in effect on the date the application was submitted, and the
- 22 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
