1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of a Center for Excellence in Deaf
3	Studies and Deaf Education at Lamar University.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 96, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 96.708 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 96.708. LAMAR UNIVERSITY CENTER FOR EXCELLENCE IN DEAF
8	STUDIES AND DEAF EDUCATION. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Board" means the board of regents of the Texas
10	State University System.
11	(2) "Center" means the Lamar University Center for
12	Excellence in Deaf Studies and Deaf Education.
13	(b) The board shall establish the Lamar University Center
14	for Excellence in Deaf Studies and Deaf Education for the purposes
15	of advancing deaf education programs in Texas by:
16	(1) collaborating with the Department of Assistive and
17	Rehabilitative Services and the Texas School for the Deaf to assess
18	deaf education needs in this state and strategies to address those
19	needs;
20	(2) studying bilingual education programs for the
21	<pre>deaf;</pre>
22	(3) studying improved teacher training; and
23	(4) studying the incorporation of technology into deaf
24	education.

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(c) The center shall develop a strategic plan to guide and 1 2 evaluate the center's progress toward achieving the purposes of the center in accordance with this section. The strategic plan must: 3 4 (1) describe the goals, objectives, and performance 5 standards for each of the center's programs and how those programs 6 help the center to achieve its purposes; 7 (2) assess the needs of the center's programs and 8 faculty; and 9 (3) assess the center's need for new initiatives. (d) The organization, control, and management of the center 10 are vested in the board. 11 12 (e) The board shall select a location for the center at Lamar University. 13 14 (f) The board may solicit, accept, and administer gifts and 15 grants from any public or private source for the use and benefit of 16 the center. 17 (g) The board may use any available funds, including legislative appropriations made to Lamar University for 18 instruction, operations, or infrastructure support, federal funds, 19 or gifts or grants to establish or operate the center. 20 21 SECTION 2. Subject to the availability of funding, the board of regents of the Texas State University System shall 22 establish the Lamar University Center for Excellence in Deaf 23 24 Studies and Deaf Education as provided by Section 96.708, Education 25 Code, as added by this Act, not later than January 1, 2007. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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3 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
