1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to designating a portion of State Highway 123 as the  
1-11 Senator John Traeger Memorial Highway.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
1-14 is amended by adding Section 225.0395 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 225.0395. SENATOR JOHN TRAEGER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)  
1-16 State Highway 123 between Interstate Highway 10 and United States  
1-17 Highway 90A is designated as the Senator John Traeger Memorial  
1-18 Highway.

1-19 (b) The department shall design and construct memorial  
1-20 markers indicating the highway number, the designation as the  
1-21 Senator John Traeger Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate  
1-22 information.

1-23 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the department  
1-24 shall erect a marker at each end of the highway and at appropriate  
1-25 intermediate sites along the highway.

1-26 (d) The department is not required to design, construct, or  
1-27 erect a marker required by this section unless a grant or donation  
1-28 of private funds is made to the department to cover the cost of the  
1-29 design, construction, and erection of the marker.

1-30 (e) Money collected under Section 225.021 for the purpose of  
1-31 implementing this section shall be deposited to the credit of the  
1-32 state highway fund.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
