1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the dissolution of the Aransas County Conservation and
1-9 Reclamation District.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. DISTRICT TO BE DISSOLVED. The Aransas County
1-12 Conservation and Reclamation District, as created by Chapter 337,
1-13 Acts of the 58th Legislature, Regular Session, 1963, shall be
1-14 dissolved as provided by this Act.

1-15 SECTION 2. TRANSFER OF ASSETS. The board of directors of
1-16 the Aransas County Conservation and Reclamation District shall pay
1-17 or provide for the payment of any debts or liabilities incurred by
1-18 the district and transfer all of the district's remaining assets to
1-19 the City of Rockport:

1-20 (1) not later than July 1, 2005, if this Act receives a
1-21 vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution; or

1-23 (2) not later than October 1, 2005, if this Act does
1-24 not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect.

1-25 SECTION 3. DATE OF DISSOLUTION. (a) The Aransas County
1-26 Conservation and Reclamation District is dissolved on:

1-27 (1) July 1, 2005, if this Act receives a vote of
1-28 two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by
1-29 Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution; or

1-30 (2) October 1, 2005, if this Act does not receive the
1-31 vote necessary for immediate effect.

1-32 (b) Any unsatisfied debt or legally established liability
1-33 of the district shall be a charge on the assets transferred until
1-34 paid.

1-35 SECTION 4. REPEALER. On the dissolution of the district,
1-36 the following laws are repealed:

1-37 (1) Chapter 337, Acts of the 58th Legislature, Regular
1-38 Session, 1963;

1-39 (2) Chapter 582, Acts of the 62nd Legislature, Regular
1-40 Session, 1971; and

1-41 (3) Chapter 271, Acts of the 66th Legislature, Regular
1-42 Session, 1979.

1-43 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
1-44 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
1-45 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
1-46 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
1-47 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
