- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 302.0027 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 302.0027. FINANCIAL LITERACY TRAINING. (a) The
- 8 <u>commission and local workforce development boards shall ensure that</u>
- 9 each workforce development program offered in this state includes
- 10 training in financial literacy.
- 11 (b) The division shall develop materials and information to
- be included in the training required by Subsection (a).
- 13 (c) The commission may accept a donation of services, money,
- or property that the commission determines furthers the financial
- 15 literacy training program. The donation must be accepted in an open
- 16 meeting by a majority of the voting members of the commission and
- 17 must be reported in the public records of the commission along with
- the name of the donor and the purpose of the donation.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
