A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to a pilot program on the use of the reverse auction
- 3 procedure by the Texas Building and Procurement Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2155.062(d), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (d) In this <u>subchapter</u> [section], "reverse auction
- 8 procedure" means:
- 9 (1) a real-time bidding process usually lasting less
- 10 than one hour and taking place at a previously scheduled time and
- 11 Internet location, in which multiple suppliers, anonymous to each
- other, submit bids to provide the designated goods or services; or
- 13 (2) a bidding process usually lasting less than two
- 14 weeks and taking place during a previously scheduled period and at a
- 15 previously scheduled Internet location, in which multiple
- 16 suppliers, anonymous to each other, submit bids to provide the
- 17 designated goods or services.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 2155, Government Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Section 2155.085 to read as follows:
- 20 <u>Sec. 2155.085.</u> REVERSE AUCTION PROCEDURE: PILOT PROGRAM.
- 21 (a) At least 30 percent of the dollar value of goods purchased by
- 22 the commission shall be purchased using the reverse auction
- 23 procedure.
- 24 (b) On or before December 1, 2006, the commission shall

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- 1 report to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the
- 2 house of representatives, the chair of the Senate Finance
- 3 Committee, and the chair of the House Appropriations Committee on
- 4 the effectiveness of using the reverse auction procedure to
- 5 purchase goods, including any cost savings realized by the state
- 6 from using the procedure.
- 7 (c) This section expires September 1, 2007.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
