H.B. No. 924

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the location of concrete stockpiles at certain portable 3 concrete crushing facilities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 382.065, Health and Safety Code, 5 is 6 amended by amending Subsections (a) and (d) and by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows: 7 (a) The commission by rule shall prohibit the operation of a 8 concrete crushing facility, including a portable concrete crushing 9 machine, within 440 yards of a building in use as a single or 10 11 multifamily residence, school, or place of worship at the time the 12 application for a permit to operate the facility at a site near the residence, school, or place of worship is filed with the 13 14 commission. The measurement of distance for purposes of this subsection shall be taken from the point on the edge of a stockpile 15 of concrete before, during, or after being crushed [the concrete 16 crushing facility] that is nearest to the residence, school, or 17 place of worship toward the point on the residence, school, or place 18 of worship that is nearest the stockpile of concrete [crushing 19 facility]. 20

(d) Notwithstanding <u>Subsections (b) and</u> [Subsection] (c),
Subsection (a) applies to a concrete crushing facility in a county
with a population of 2.4 million or more or in a county adjacent to
such a county.

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(e) The commission shall require a permit holder who 1 2 operates a portable concrete crushing machine in violation of this section to cease operations unless the permit holder brings the 3 4 operation into compliance with this section at the site at which the violation occurred or relocates the operation to a site in 5 6 compliance with this section not later than the first anniversary of the date on which the permit holder receives notice of the 7 This subsection does not limit the commission's 8 violation. authority to further enforce this section under Chapter 7, Water 9 10 Code.

SECTION 2. (a) On or after the effective date of this Act, 11 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality shall deny an 12 application for the issuance, amendment, renewal, or transfer of a 13 14 permit, registration, or permit by rule for a portable concrete 15 crushing machine and may not issue, amend, renew, or transfer a permit, registration, or permit by rule for a portable concrete 16 17 crushing machine if the commission determines that the machine would be operated or is being operated in violation of Section 18 382.065, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act. 19

(b) A person operating a portable concrete crushing machine
under a permit issued before the effective date of this Act and
whose operation of the machine is in violation of Section 382.065,
Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act, shall bring the
operation of the machine into compliance with that section not
later than September 1, 2006.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
