- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 33.115, Natural Resources Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 § 33.115. PIERS. (a) Without obtaining an easement from the
- 7 board, the owner of littoral property may construct a pier \underline{on}
- 8 adjacent coastal public land if the pier [which]:
- 9 (1) [may be used for any purpose except] is not used
- 10 <u>for</u> commercial purposes;
- 11 (2) is 115 feet or less in length and 25 feet or less in
- 12 width; and,
- 13 (3) requires no filling or dredging.
- 14 (b) In addition to the provisions of subsection (a), the
- 15 board may adopt rules with limitations and requirements that are
- 16 consistent with the policies stated in Section 33.001 of this Code
- 17 that allow an owner of littoral property to construct a pier with
- 18 <u>associated appurtenances on adjacent coastal public land without</u>
- 19 first obtaining an easement from the board.
- 20 (c) The location and dimensions of the pier and description
- 21 of any associated appurtenances must be registered with the board
