- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 37.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 37.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. (a) The holder of a
- 8 nonresident seller's permit may:
- 9 (1) solicit and take orders for liquor from permittees
- 10 authorized to import liquor into this state; and
- 11 (2) ship liquor into this state, or cause it to be
- 12 shipped into this state, in consummation of sales made to
- 13 permittees authorized to import liquor into the state.
- 14 (b) The holder of a nonresident seller's permit who owns a
- 15 winery outside of the state may conduct wine samplings, including
- wine tastings, at a retailer's premises. An employee of the winery
- 17 may open, touch, or pour wine, make a presentation, or answer
- 18 questions at a wine sampling.
- 19 (c) Any wine used in a wine sampling under this section must
- 20 be purchased from the retailer on whose premises the wine sampling
- 21 is held. This section does not authorize the holder of a
- 22 nonresident seller's permit or manufacturer's agent's permit to
- 23 withdraw or purchase wine from the holder of a wholesaler's permit
- or provide wine for a sampling on a retailer's premises that is not

- 1 purchased from the retailer. The amount of wine purchased from the
- 2 retailer may not exceed the amount of wine used in the sampling.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
