Section 37.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 37.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. (a) The holder of a 7 nonresident seller's permit may: 8 (1) solicit and take orders for liquor from permittees 9 authorized to import liquor into this state; and 10 11 (2) ship liquor into this state, or cause it to be 12 shipped into this state, in consummation of sales made to permittees authorized to import liquor into the state. 13 14 (b) The holder of a nonresident seller's permit who owns a winery outside of the state may conduct wine samplings, including 15 16 wine tastings, at a retailer's premises. An employee of the winery may open, touch, or pour wine, make a presentation, or answer 17 18 questions at a wine sampling. (c) Any wine used in a wine sampling under this section must 19 be purchased from the retailer on whose premises the wine sampling 20 21 is held. This section does not authorize the holder of a nonresident seller's permit or manufacturer's agent's permit to 22 withdraw or purchase wine from the holder of a wholesaler's permit 23 or provide wine for a sampling on a retailer's premises that is not 24

1	purchased from the retailer. The amount of wine purchased from the
2	retailer may not exceed the amount of wine used in the sampling.
3	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
