- 5 SECTION 1. Section 36.05, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is

- 7 Sec. 36.05. SAMPLES. (a) Except as provided by Subsection
- 8 (b), the [The] holder of a manufacturer's agent's permit may not
- 9 transport or carry liquor as samples, but may carry or display empty
- 10 sample containers.
- 11 (b) The holder of a manufacturer's agent's permit may
- transport samples of wine for a wine sampling under Section 37.01.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 37.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 37.01. AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES. (a) The holder of a
- 16 nonresident seller's permit may:
- 17 (1) solicit and take orders for liquor from permittees
- 18 authorized to import liquor into this state;
- 19 (2) ship liquor into this state, or cause it to be
- 20 shipped into this state, in consummation of sales made to
- 21 permittees authorized to import liquor into the state.
- 22 (b) The holder of a nonresident seller's permit who owns a
- 23 winery outside of the state may conduct wine samplings, including

- 1 may open, touch, or pour wine, make a presentation, or answer
- 2 questions at a wine sampling.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
