A dealer must have a license for 17 18 each place of business owned and operated by the person. SECTION 3. Section 31.0412, Parks and Wildlife Code, is 19 amended to read as follows: 20 Sec. 31.0412. LICENSING RULES. The commission may adopt 21 22 rules regarding licenses issued under Section 31.041, including 23 rules: regarding license transfer procedures; 24 (1)
