- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 31.156(d), Natural Resources Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:
- (d) The division shall submit to the commissioner [any]

  transaction involving the real property, including [the market
  walue of the real property, current market conditions, and] an
  evaluation of any proposals received from private parties that

- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
