- 7 by adding Section 245.007 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 245.007. CONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATION WORK ON
- 9 COUNTY-OWNED BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a)
- 10 This section applies only to a building or facility that is owned by
- 11 a county with a population of 3.3 million or more and is located
- 12 within the boundaries of another political subdivision.
- (b) A political subdivision may not require a county to
- 14 notify the political subdivision or obtain a building permit for
- 15 any new construction or any renovation of a building or facility
- 16 owned by the county if the construction or renovation work is
- 17 supervised and inspected by an engineer or architect licensed in
- 18 <u>this state.</u>
- (c) This section does not exempt a county from complying
- 20 with the building standards of the political subdivision during the
- 21 construction or renovation of the building or facility.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
