- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 382, Health and Safety 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 382.0275 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 382.0275. PROHIBITION ON COMMISSION ACTION RELATING TO
- 8 RESIDENTIAL WATER HEATERS. (a) In this section, "residential
- 9 water heater" means a water heater that:
- 10 (1) is designed primarily for residential use; and
- 11 (2) has a maximum rated capacity of 75,000 British
- 12 thermal units per hour (Btu/hr) or less.
- (b) The commission may not adopt or enforce a rule,
- 14 determination, or order that relates to emissions from residential
- 15 water heaters.

- 16 (c) Any emission reductions related to residential gas
- 17 water heaters that the commission does not adopt because of
- 18 Subsection (b) shall be replaced by a requirement that will obtain
- 19 emission reductions from the same category.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
