5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 382, Health and Safety

7	Sec. 382.0275. COMMISSION ACTION RELATING TO RESIDENTIAL
8	WATER HEATERS. (a) In this section, "residential water heater"
9	means a water heater that:
10	(1) is designed primarily for residential use; and
11	(2) has a maximum rated capacity of 75,000 British
12	thermal units per hour (Btu/hr) or less.
13	(b) The commission shall direct the executive director to
14	perform a study, to be completed by December 31, 2005, regarding the
15	technical and economic feasibility of regulating residential water
16	heaters. If the executive director's study shows that regulation
17	of residential water heaters is technically or economically
18	infeasible, the executive director shall recommend to the
19	commission that the rules concerning water heaters be repealed not
20	later than December 31, 2006, and shall propose emission reductions
21	to offset the loss of state implementation plan credits from the
22	rules. The commission shall provide notice of and hold a public
23	hearing on the study.
24	(c) Any emission reductions related to residential gas

1	water heaters that the commission does not adopt because of
2	Subsection (b) shall be replaced by a requirement that will obtain
3	emission reductions from the same category.
4	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
5	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
6	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
7	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

8 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
