- a county commissioners court may not dispense with the requirement 8
- of a culpable mental state if the offense is punishable by a fine 9
- exceeding the amount authorized by Section 12.23. 10
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 11
- 12 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 13
- covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 14
- former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 15
- this section, an offense is committed before the effective date of 16
- this Act if any element of the offense occurs before the effective 17
- date. 18
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 19
