AUTOMATIC ADJUSTMENT FOR CHANGES IN COSTS. 7 Except as permitted by Section 36.204 or 36.209, the commission may 8 not establish a rate or tariff that authorizes an electric utility 9 to automatically adjust and pass through to the utility's customers 10 11 a change in the utility's fuel or other costs. 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 36, Utilities Code, is 13 amended by adding Section 36.209 to read as follows: 14 Sec. 36.209. RECOVERY BY CERTAIN NON-ERCOT UTILITIES OF CERTAIN TRANSMISSION COSTS. (a) This section applies only to an 15 electric utility that operates solely outside of ERCOT in areas of 16 this state not included in the Southeastern Electric Reliability 17 18 Council on January 1, 2005, and that owns or operates transmission 19 facilities.

20 (b) The commission may establish a mechanism to permit an 21 electric utility to which this section applies to timely and 22 periodically recover transmission infrastructure improvement costs 23 and changes in wholesale transmission charges to the electric 24 utility under a tariff approved by a federal regulatory authority.

1	A mechanism adopted under this subsection may allow the utility to
2	recover only the costs allocable to retail customers in this state
3	and may not allow the utility to over-recover costs.
4	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
5	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
6	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
7	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
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8 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
