(a) A person who has a right 7 of first refusal in real property may not charge a fee for declining 8 9 to exercise that right, such as a fee for providing written evidence of the declination. 10 11 (b) A title company shall accept written evidence that a 12 person has solicited a fee under Subsection (a) as proof that the person has waived the right of first refusal. 13 SECTION 2. Except as provided by a contract entered into 14 before the effective date of this Act, Section 5.014, Property 15 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a fee that is solicited 16 on or after the effective date of this Act for declining the 17 exercise of a right of first refusal. 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 23
