- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 52.072, Election Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 6 (e) A proposition must state the principal purpose of the
- 7 measure and may not contain more than 75 words. A proposition
- 8 heading may not contain more than 15 words. The limits imposed by
- 9 this subsection do not apply to the Spanish translation of a
- 10 proposition or proposition heading.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 274.001(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 (b) The proposition prescribed by the secretary of state
- 14 must describe the proposed amendment in terms that clearly express
- its scope and character and may not contain more than 75 words. The
- 16 limit imposed by this subsection does not apply to the Spanish
- 17 translation of a proposition.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- an election ordered on or after September 1, 2005.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
