5	SECTION 1. Section 30.05, Penal Code, is amended by adding
6	Subsections (g) and (h) to read as follows:
7	(g) This section does not apply if:
8	(1) the basis on which entry on the property or land or
9	in the building was forbidden is that entry with a handgun or other
10	weapon was forbidden; and
11	(2) the actor at the time of the offense was a peace
12	officer, including a commissioned peace officer of a recognized
13	state, or a special investigator under Article 2.122, Code of
14	Criminal Procedure, regardless of whether the peace officer or
15	special investigator was engaged in the actual discharge of an
16	official duty while carrying the weapon.
17	(h) For purposes of Subsection (g), "recognized state" has
18	the meaning assigned by Section 46.15.
19	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
20	to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
21	An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
22	governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and
23	the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
24	purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the

1 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was 2 committed before that date.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
