12	fee for a qualified disabled veteran and for a resident on active
13	duty as a member of the United States military forces.
14	SECTION 2. Section 46.004(c), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	(c) The commission shall waive the fee for a qualified
17	disabled veteran as defined by Section 42.012 and for a resident on
18	active duty as a member of the United States military forces.
19	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
