## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the maximum value of a charitable raffle prize.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2002.056, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> (b-1) and
- 8 [Subsection] (c), the value of a prize offered or awarded at a
- 9 raffle that is purchased by the organization or for which the
- organization provides any consideration may not exceed \$50,000.
- 11 (b-1) The value of a residential dwelling offered or awarded
- 12 as a prize at a raffle that is purchased by the organization or for
- 13 which the organization provides any consideration may not exceed
- 14 \$250,000.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 16 raffle conducted under Chapter 2002, Occupations Code, if the
- 17 prizes are awarded on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 18 raffle for which the prizes are awarded before the effective date of
- 19 this Act is covered by the law in effect when the prizes were
- 20 awarded, and the former law is continued in effect for purposes of
- 21 any criminal liability arising under that law before the effective
- 22 date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
