12	participate in employment or a school-related activity or because

14	(2) with more than one passenger in the vehicle under
15	21 years of age who is not a family member <u>; or</u>
16	(3) while using a wireless communications device.
17	(b) A person under 17 years of age who holds a restricted
18	motorcycle license or moped license, during the six-month period
19	following the issuance of an original motorcycle license or moped
20	license to the person, may not operate a motorcycle or moped <u>:</u>
21	(1) after midnight and before 5 a.m. unless:
22	(A) $[(1)]$ the person is in sight of the person's
23	parent or guardian; or
24	(B) [(2)] the operation of the vehicle is

1	necessary for the operator to attend or participate in employment
2	or a school-related activity or because of a medical emergency; or
3	(2) while using a wireless communications device.
4	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
