- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Sections 545.424(a) and (b), Transportation 5 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- A person under 18 years of age, during the six-month 7 period following issuance of an original Class A, B, or C driver's 8 license to the person, may not operate a motor vehicle:
- (1) after midnight and before 5 a.m. unless the 10 11 operation of the vehicle is necessary for the operator to attend or 12 participate in employment or a school-related activity or because of a medical emergency; [or] 13
- (2) with more than one passenger in the vehicle under 14 21 years of age who is not a family member; or 15
- (3) while using a wireless communications device. 16
- A person under 17 years of age who holds a restricted 17 18 motorcycle license or moped license, during the six-month period following the issuance of an original motorcycle license or moped 19 license to the person, may not operate a motorcycle or moped $\underline{\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$ 20
